Background

The Government of South Africa has identified that the fourth industrial revolution will have huge implications on the economy of South Africa. In January 2019, the South African Minister of Finance indicated that the country needs to prepare itself for the fourth industrial revolution and that the budget will include issues such as overhauling previously underprivileged schools and investment in digital and technological skills. In order to facilitate a plan of action, Government has established a commission to organize a 'national response action plan to deal with the fourth industrial revolution'. The President of South Africa has indicated that:

“Our prosperity as a nation depends on our ability to take full advantage of rapid technological change. This means that we urgently need to develop our capabilities in the areas of science, technology and innovation.”

South African cities have been facing challenges since democratization to meet the expectations of the citizens. The challenges have included fraud and corruption, financial constraints, lack of service delivery and technological progress, amongst others, which were underpinned by weak leadership and governance processes.





Transparency



South Africa was just been faced with an unrest because of social inequalities from the 8th of July 2021 for about a week, because of looting and strikes. Digitalizing systems in place could make it possible to solve simple solutions like the distribution of grants to help those in-need. Some of the reasons for lack of funds are due to mismanagement of funds and there are no records to support or audit.

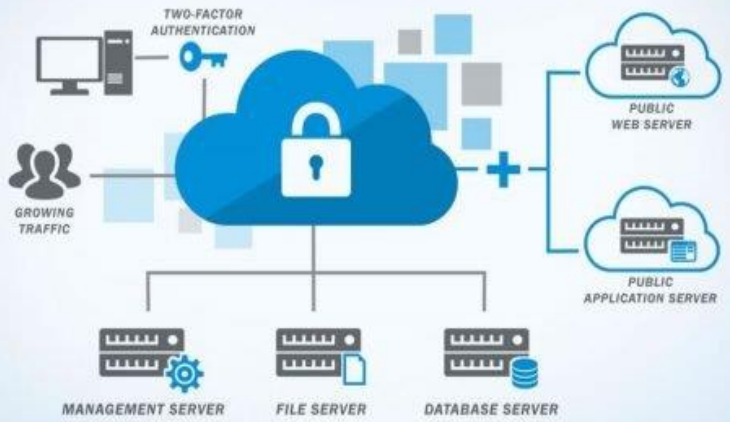


Convenient and Accessible
